APPROVED POLICIES

Policy 1.120 Superintendent of Schools Roles and Responsibilities (including Appendix A and B).

The Board of Education approved the 2024-2025 Budget Development Process, which will begin in January 2024. The process will occur over six months and will include development and approval of the 2024-2025 district budget, as well as the development and approval of the 2023-2024 amended budget.

The district will be undergoing a public consultation process regarding the proposed changes to two of the electoral boundaries in the district. In September, the Board of Education receives an Operational Plan that identifies the actions that will be taken towards the fulfillment of the goals and objectives. In January of each year, the board receives a report that measures the progress towards achieving the goals and objectives of the strategic plan.
